Nationally Recognised Training

Course Objectives

This qualification reflects the role of workers in the residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason.

Vocational Outcomes

After achieving this qualification, candidates may continue studies in the CHC43015 Certificate IV in Ageing Support or CHC43115 Certificate IV in Disability. Graduates have a wide range of employment options such as Residential care worker, Home care assistant, Personal care assistant.

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements to this program. You will be required to successfully complete an ACSF language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) assessment. A clear Police Record Check with no disclosures is mandatory for practical placement.

Duration & Delivery Methods

1 year including 13 units of study, 7 core units and 6 electives units. (Course duration may vary, depending on previous education or delivery hours).

Classroom based delivery (12 hours/week) with a required 120 hours of placement for specific units of competency, placement services provided by AVWA.

Assessment Methods

Assessment framework may contain a combination of questions & answers, case studies, roleplay, project work, Journal, practical demonstration and a third party report. Students must successfully complete all workplace assessments and in-class assessments to be deemed competent for any unit.
