Nationally Recognised Training

Course Outline

This course provides a comprehensive training program to meet the needs of the Children's Services industry. Students will be equipped with the skills and knowledge for a challenging career with young children aged from 0-6 years.

Vocational Outcomes

Students may continue studies to CHC50113 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care. Students who complete this course could obtain positions such as: Early childhood educator, Playgroup supervisor, Family day care worker, or Nanny.

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements to this program. You will be required to successfully complete an ACSF language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) assessment. A clear Police Record Check with no disclosures and a Working with Children Check are mandatory for practical placement.

Duration & Delivery Methods

1 Year including 18 units of study, 15 core units and 3 electives units. (Course duration may vary, depending on previous education or delivery hours).

Classroom based delivery (14hrs/week) with a required 120 hours of placement in an accredited childcare centre (Long Day Care), placement services provided by AVWA.

Assessment Methods

Assessment framework may contain a combination of questions & answers, scenario, research and/or project work, practical demonstration and third party report.
