Course Outline

This course provides a comprehensive training program to meet the needs of the Children's Services industry. Students will be equipped with the skills and knowledge for a challenging career with young children aged from 0-6 years.

Vocational Outcomes

Students who complete this course will obtain positions such as: early childhood educator, playgroup supervisor, or family day care coordinator. A student may also choose to pursue further studies at a higher level.

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements to this program. You will be required to successfully complete an ACSF language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) assessment. A clear Police Record Check with no disclosures and a Working with Children Check are mandatory for practical placement.

Duration & Delivery Methods

- 54 weeks (Course duration may vary, depending on previous education and delivery hours).
- Classroom based delivery (14hrs/week) with a required 240 hours of placement in an accredited centre based.

Assessment Methods

Assessment framework may contain a combination of questions & answers, scenario, research and/or project work, practical demonstration and third party report, placement services provided by AVWA. Students must successfully complete all workplace assessments and in-class assessments to be deemed competent for any unit.
